On September 24, 2021 I, L. Warbis #164, was working as a general commissioned uniformed police officer for the City of Lake Stevens police department driving a marked police vehicle equipped with emergency lights and siren.

Narrative:

On September 24th 2021, At shift debriefing I was advised by dayshift that they attempted to serve an order at 9206 15th St NE, LKS. The petitioner Richard Boyle (08/15/1969) called one of the dayshift officers and he advised the respondent Tania Angel (04/23/1976) vehicle was currently at their residence 9206 15th St NE, LKS. I took the order from the dayshift officers and I saw it was a move out order.

I advised dispatch I was going to attempt service at the address and Officer Anderson said he would accompany me. I arrived at the above address with Officer Anderson. I saw there was a white Mercedes C-Class with affixed Washington State Registration AYM8800 in the driveway of the residence. I knocked on the door and Tania answered it in a towel, I asked Tania to get dressed so we could talk.

Tania opened the garage door and I told her that I was there to serve a protection order. I also advised Tania that the order indicated she needed to move out of the residence. I handed Tania the order and she began to flip through the pages. I told Tania she needed to grab enough items for the night and leave the house. Tania began to complain that she was the victim and everything in the order was a lie. Tania asked me how I could kick her out of the residence when she had nowhere to go, and she had a 16-year-old daughter. I told Tania I was simply doing what the judge ordered and she needed to grab her items while we were there, and she needed to leave.

Officer Anderson called Sergeant Thomas, he advised Tania that she had full knowledge of the order being served and her refusal to leave the house could result in her arrest if Richard came home. We asked Tania if she had anyone that she could stay with, she said no. Tania then began to walk away and she said she would figure something out as she closed the garage door.

Officer Anderson and I returned to our patrol cars. While I was adding notes to the call, Tania called, and she asked for an officer to contact her at the house. I called Sergeant Thomas, he advised me that Tania had ample amount of time to leave the residence at this point and the petitioner was waiting to go home. Sergeant Thomas advised Tania should be placed under arrest for refusing to comply with the order.

I told Officer Anderson we were going to recontact Tania. As we approached the house Tania came outside. I told Tania we wanted to talk to her, she said you aren't going to arrest me are you. Tania was hesitant to leave the front

door of the residence. I asked Tania to take a seat on the front steps of the residence, she refused, and she became emotional stating she was the victim and we had it all wrong. Officer Anderson and I attempted to lead Tania away from the front door. She walked with us, but she was very tense, and she tried several times to pull away. Officer Anderson placed Tania into handcuffs. I did a search incident to arrest and I located nothing of interest.

Tania was placed in the rear of the patrol vehicle. Sergeant Thomas explained to her as I previously stated that the judge issued a move out order and she was to leave the residence. Tania agreed to cooperate with us if we took her out of custody. Tania was released from custody and give fifteen minutes to gather her items.

Once Tania was done gather items, she asked us to view videos that were to support her allegations of her being the victim of domestic violence. I did not see any photos or videos of a physical altercation or bruising by Richard. I heard Richard calling her an attention whore regarding her Facebook. Based on the items that Tania showed me, I did not have enough probable cause to believe a crime had been committed.

Tania was provided resources for domestic violence and homelessness.

This ends my involvement in this case.

Recommendations:

I recommend this case be closed.

Narrative:

On the time and date of this incident, I, Alan Anderson, was assigned to patrol in the city of Lake Stevens, WA. I was operating a fully marked patrol car with large reflective words "POLICE" on both the driver and passenger side of the vehicle. My patrol vehicle has an attached overhead emergency light bar with both red and blue LED lighting. My vehicle is also equipped with an external siren. During patrol, I was wearing a uniform with the department patches on each shoulder.

Narrative:

On September 24, 2021, at about 1810 hours, I covered Officer Warbis while she served a Move Out order to Tania Loraine Angel, at 9206 15th St NE, Lake Stevens.

Tania answered the door covered in a bath towel and Officer Warbis asked her to get dressed. Tania returned to the door dressed and we agreed to speak with her in the garage so her pet dog would not be a factor during our contact.

Officer Warbis gave Tania the order and explained it was a move out order and protection order. Tania stated she did not understand what was going on and she told us we were protecting the wrong person.

I told Tania we were not protecting anyone, we were serving a court order and she needed to gather her personal affects and leave today. Tania told us we would have to arrest her to get her to leave. Tania went inside the house and closed the garage roll-up door.

Officer Warbis called Sgt. Thomas and gave him an update. Sgt. Thomas instructed us to arrest Tania for violating the order.

As we approached the house, Tania opened the front door and asked if we were going to arrest her. I told Tania we were instructed to arrest her. Tania said, "No you're not" and stepped back into the house.

Tania stated she had videos on her phone that proved she has been treated unfairly by the petitioner on the order. I

did not want to chase Tania through her house, so I asked her to show me the videos on her phone. Tania walked off the porch and tried to unlock her cell phone. I took Tania by the left arm and told her she was under arrest. Tania resisted and I instructed her not to fight me or pull away from me. Tania continued to resist so I pulled her in front of the garage, hoping to take away her hope of running back into the house.

Officer Warbis held onto Tania's right arm while I placed her in handcuffs. I check the cuffs for proper fit and double locked them. I asked Officer Warbis to bring her patrol unit into the driveway, so we would not have far to get Tania secured in the back seat. I checked the back seat before Tania sat down and no contraband was found. Tania was uninjured and did not have a complaint of pain or injury. Neither were there any visible signs of injury.

I Officer Warbis aired we had one in custody. And Sgt. Thomas responded to our location. Sgt. Thomas had a conversation with Tania and told her to follow the instructions in the order. Tania agreed to gather some things for herself and her daughter and call the PD on Monday to request a civic standby.

Tania was released and I later helped her carry her things to her vehicle in the driveway. Tania then showed a couple of videos to Officer Warbis. We encouraged Tania to share the videos with Superior Family Court. But Tania stated she did not want to get her ex-boyfriend in trouble.

Tania drove away while we were still there.

I returned to my patrol duties.

On approximately Aug 20, 2021, After I left the property for my safety and ensure I could not be falsely accused of any abuse as she has done in previous situations, I got an alert from my Ring doorbell installed on my house. The video revealed that she ripped the Ring doorbell off the house leaving damage as shown in the picture. Through various notifications from the Ring doorbell, she has hidden the doorbell, my property from me. She has taken away my right to have video surveillance of my home for my personal protection. This has reinforced my concern of my safety and personal well being due to prior history previously noted with prior spouse.

. I have Ring doorbell footage showing her ripping the device off my house leaving damage. I also have a picture of the resulting damage. The video and picture will not upload in file below. Available on request. .

Describe the past incidents where you experienced violence, where you were afraid of injury or where the respondent threatened to harm or kill you:

On July 31st, 2021 while camping at the Gorge Tania punched me twice in the back. This action was unprovoked. This was witnessed by a mutual friend of ours, Luke Schmale (585)301-6919. He escorted me away to safety.

Tania has displayed aggressive and provoking behavior to include blocking me in a room while provoking me and verbally abusing on multiple occasions. This behavior was also witnessed by her previous spouse and he has warned me to be careful of Tania's intentions.

I can provide 8 witness that will verify the information I have provided here.

The violence has become increasing aggressive and now includes property damage which as mentioned earlier restricts surveillance in my own home leading me to be concerned about what

she doesn't want caught on film.

As of 9/21/21 she has also taken and hidden the keys to my vehicle which prohibits me from getting to and from work.

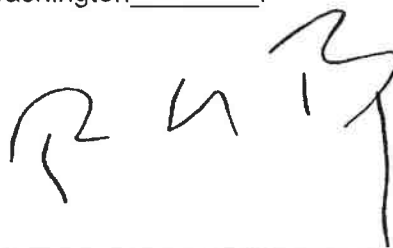

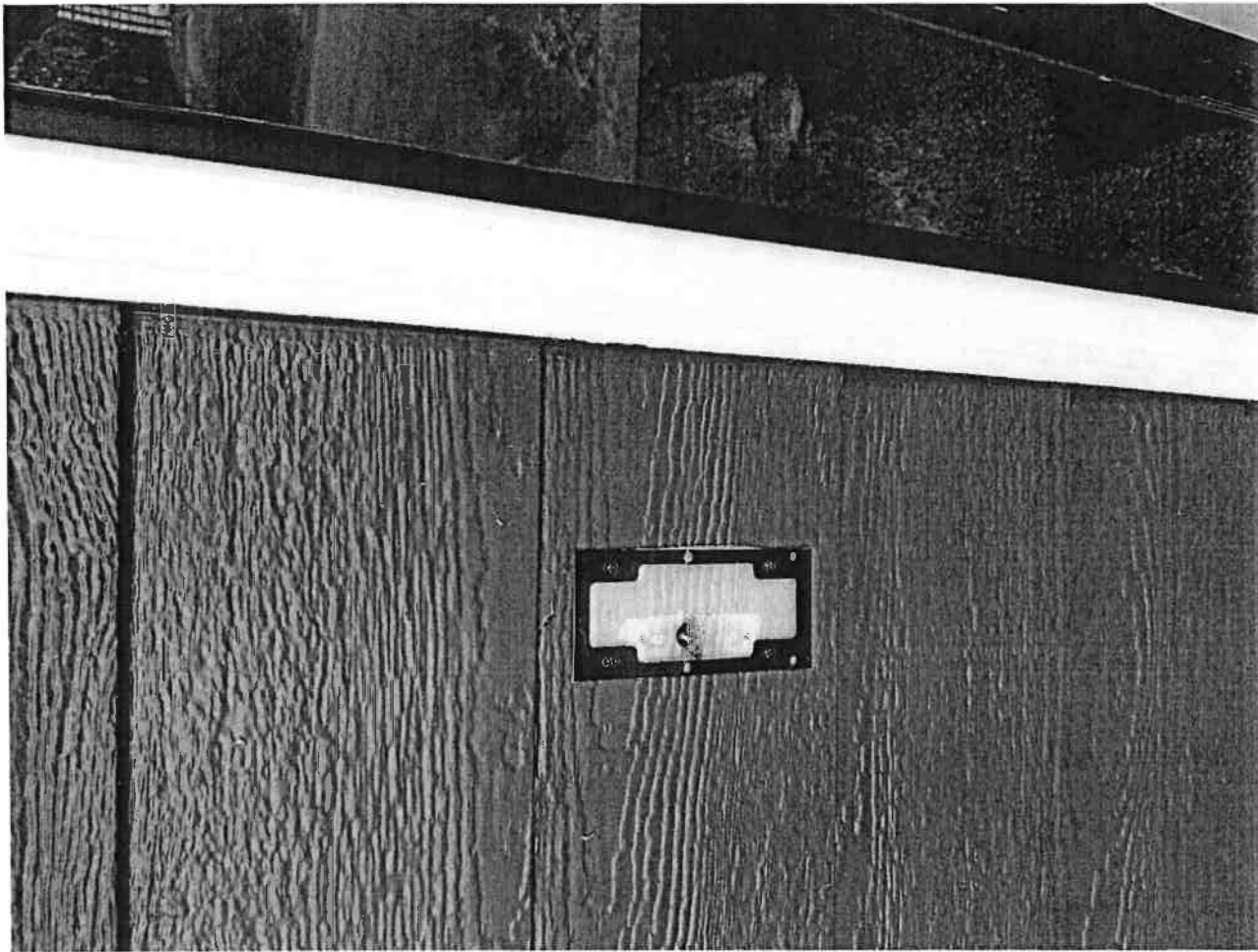

On approximately Aug 20, 2021, After I left the property for my safety and ensure I could not be falsely accused of any abuse as she has done in previous situations, I got an alert from my Ring doorbell installed on my house. The video revealed that she ripped the Ring doorbell off the house leaving damage as shown in the picture. Through various notifications from the Ring doorbell, she has hidden the doorbell, my property from me. She has taken away my right to have video surveillance of my home for my personal protection. This has reinforced my concern of my safety and personal well being due to prior history previously noted with prior spouse.

. I have Ring doorbell footage showing her ripping the device off my house leaving damage. I also have a picture of the resulting damage. The video and picture will not upload in file below. Available on request. .

Describe the past incidents where you experienced violence, where you were afraid of injury or where the respondent threatened to harm or kill you:

On July 31st, 2021 while camping at the Gorge Tania punched me twice in the back. This action was unprovoked. This was witnessed by a mutual friend of ours, Luke Schmale (585)301-6919. He escorted me away to safety.

Tania has displayed aggressive and provoking behavior to include blocking me in a room while provoking me and verbally abusing on multiple occasions. This behavior was also witnessed by her previous spouse and he has warned me to be careful of Tania's intentions.

I can provide 8 witness that will verify the information I have provided here.

The violence has become increasing aggressive and now includes property damage which as mentioned earlier restricts surveillance in my own home leading me to be concerned about what

she doesn't want caught on film.

As of 9/21/21 she has also taken and hidden the keys to my vehicle which prohibits me from getting to and from work.

She has tracked me down at friend's houses and public venues such as restaurants when I have left the house to avoid conflict with her following a fit of her rage. 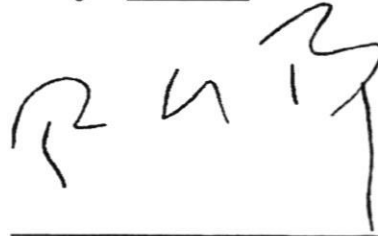

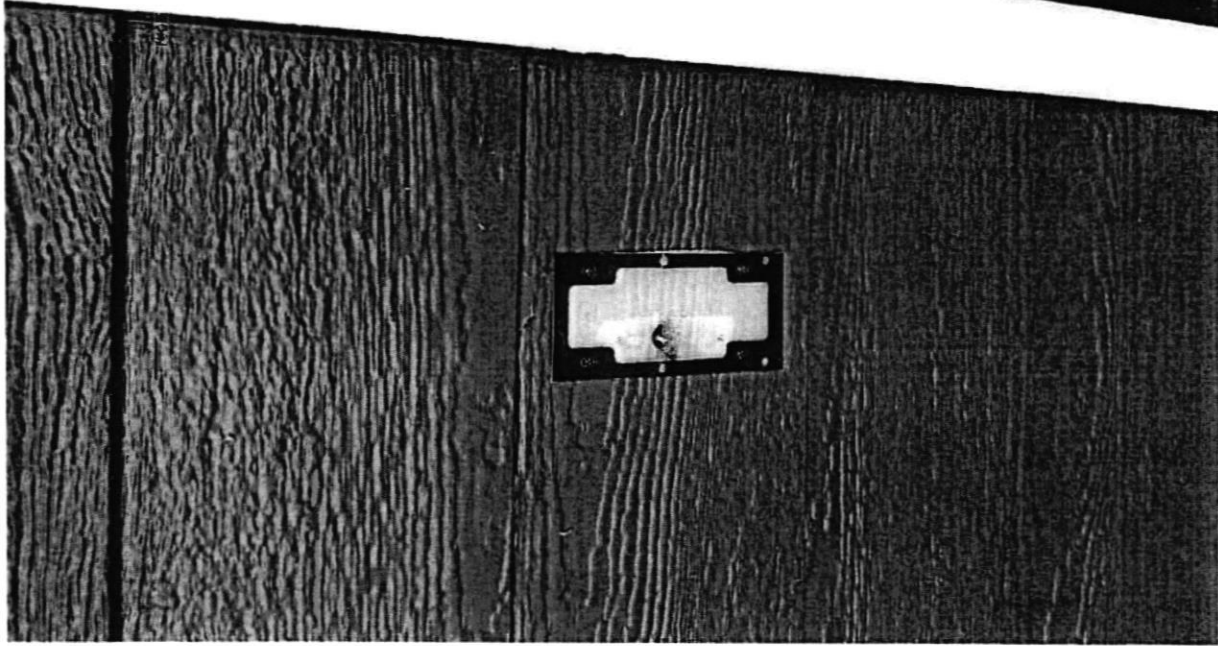
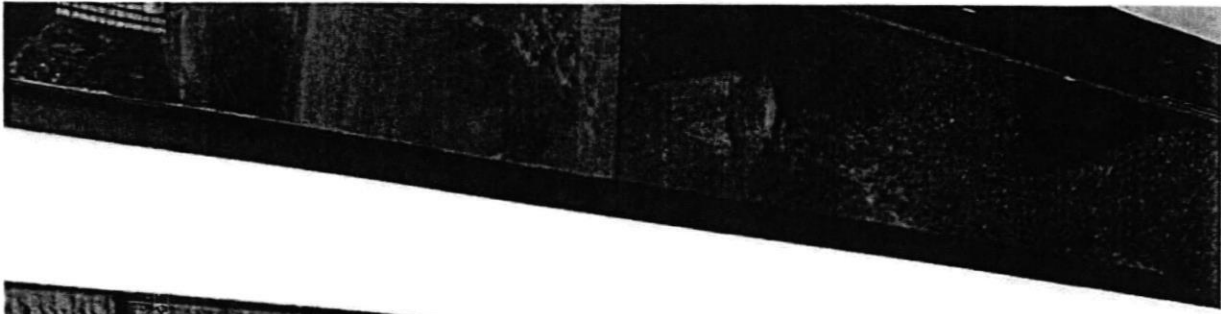
