Commander Beazizio would like you to start an admin review in BlueTeam on this complaint from Diana McCorkle. On April 22, 2021, I fielded a complaint from her regarding the treatment she received from Corporal Adam Bryant on a DV call on Saturday, April 17, 2021 (2021-7754.) Corporal Christensen fielded a complaint on April 19, 2021 from Diana (2021-7880.) I don't know the outcome of that call other than what Chad entered into the call when it cleared it (she wanted some answers as to why her husband had not been released from jail.)

On April 22, 2021, Diana called to complain about Corporal Bryant lying to her multiple times regarding our city prosecutor, court system that we use, and that she didn't feel assaulted. She said a lot of things during the phone call that I cannot remember, but she was very angry and wanted something done.

I sent her a statement form through email, but have not received anything back. She said she was going to go to the governor to investigate the LSPD. It looks like she started with Rep. Lovick.

I don't have any more information.

Let me know if there is anything I can do to help on this.

I requested the police report and after reading it I was shocked at the inconsistencies and the outright falsehoods contained inside. James Barnes then promised to call me back after speaking with Corporal Adam Bryant about my concerns and he never called back. He treated me like I had made the whole thing up and said that Officer Bryant refuted all my statements.
