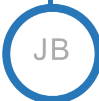
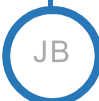

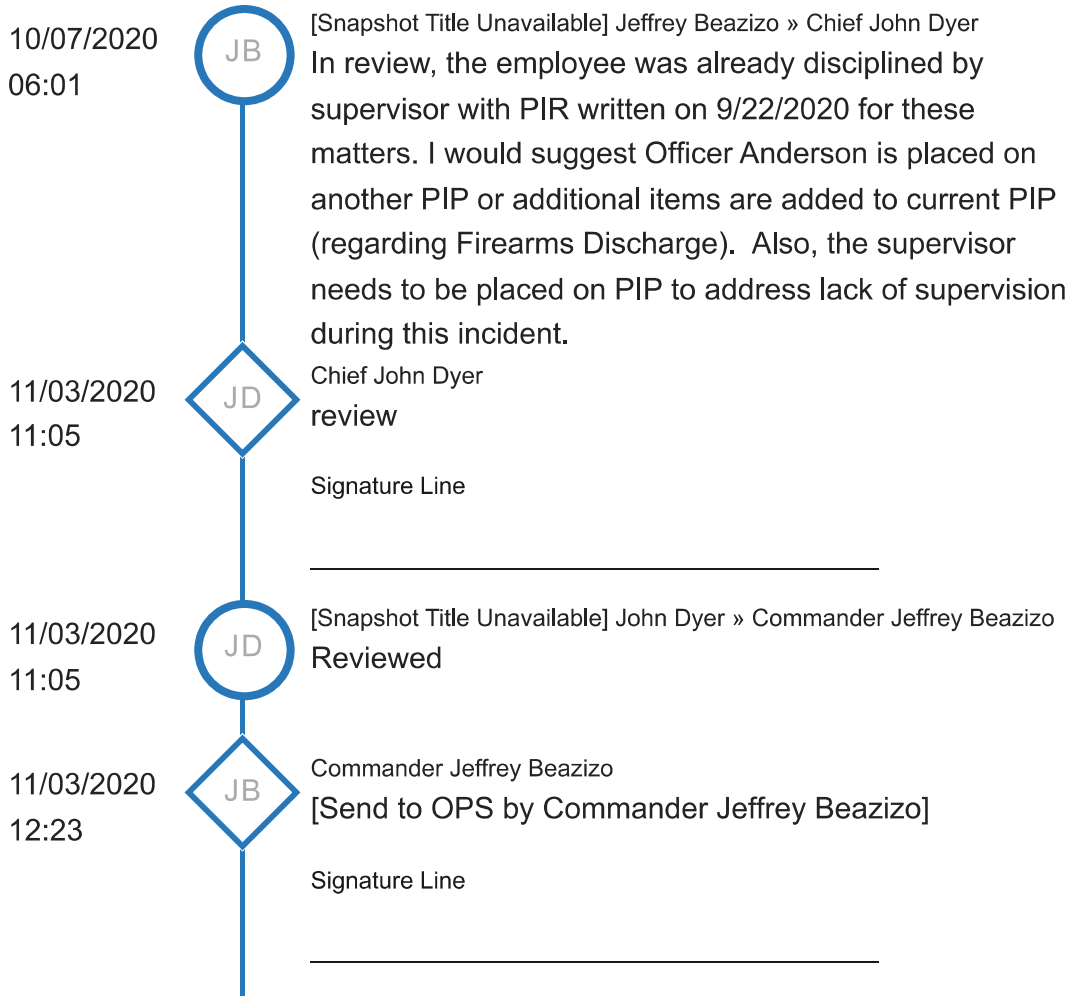

As far as the DV order violation goes, Here are my thoughts. I would have at least wrote a report documenting the investigation that was conducted and its results. During an investigation, just because the victim "dropped the whole thing and was done," we still need document that. This was still a possible DV Order violation. Not that it changes anything, just raises the stakes, but the DV order was between a rape victim and her attacker (husband). I'm not sure going back 3 months later and changing the call status to a suspicious is the right thing to do. IF it turns out no violation occurred, then so be it. But that needs to be documented after an investigation has already started. If this was not a violation at the time responding, then change it at that point. So those are my thoughts on this. Sorry we cant talk in person, so much better then email. Ill leave this in your hands. If you have any questions, please let me know

I, Sergeant Miner, am a fully commissioned police officer assigned to the Investigations Unit of the Lake Stevens Police Department, located in Snohomish County; State of Washington.

9-22-20, I pulled a copy of the DV protection order between Rebbecca Johnson and Travis Johnson. In the order, at #9 under the court orders, it states "Both parties are restrained from closing community accounts or spending or disposing of community assets except for daily living expenses." The allegations against Travis Johnson is the he closed a bank account in violation of this order. It is said to that the account was only in Travis' name, but this is unconfirmed. It is unknown if Rebbecca had access to the account prior to the order, or if this account is considered community property. It should also be noted that this violation as reported by Rebbecca on 6-24-20.

9-23-20, I contacted Rebbecca Johnson over the phone. I explained the reason for my call stating I was looking into the order violation that she reported. I told her I had pulled a copy of the order and made myself familiar with it. I asked her which bank account this violation was referring to and she stated the US Bank account. I asked if this account was a joint account at the time it was closed, and she said it was. Rebbecca stated that Travis was the primary account holder and she was the secondary, reiterating that she was on the account. She said because she was not the primary account holder, she would not be able to close the account unless Travis was deceased and she had a death certificate. I asked how she accessed the account and she stated she had and still has the debit/bank card for it.

I asked if she would be able to get the bank account information from the bank and she said yes. I told her I needed the records that show the bank name, account number, the names of the account holders and the date that it was closed. Rebbecca said she can and would obtain the bank documents and get them to me soon. I also requested that she take photo of her debit/bank card associated with the bank account and also send that to me. Finally, I emailed her a statement form which I requested her to fill out and forward to me.

9-24-20 at around 0830. I attempted to contact Travis Johnson several times (Throughout the day) concerning this case. The number on file just hangs up and does not answer. Finally, during one of the calls, I noticed that "busy" flashes on the phone screen just before the line I disconnected. It does not give you the option to leave a message. I have not been able to locate another phone number or address for Travis. On a previous order violation, 20-7132, Travis refused to speak to the investigating officer about the case. I did speak with Rebbecca who confirmed the listed number is correct. She does not know where he is currently residing, but it is in Marysville somewhere.

9-24-20 at around 1236 hours, I received an email from Rebbecca. The email had 2 attachments which were her US Bank Statement and her written statement. I added both of these documents to the case file.

I opened and reviewed the attached US Bank statement. The statement is of US Bank account number 1-535-9573-2865. Listed on the account is both Travis and Rebbecca Johnson. The account shows that it was closed on 6-5-20, which the served DV Protection Order was in play.

Rebbecca also stated that while she was obtaining the paperwork of the US Bank account, she learned that another joint account was also closed. She will be attempting to obtain the paperwork for that account.

9-28-20. I made attempts contact Travis Johnson with no luck. The goes to busy status and hangs up as before; still unable to leave a message. I also sent a message to Rebbecca Johnson asking for an update if she was able to obtain the bank records from the other closed account.

9-29-20, 0830 hours. I spoke with Rebbecca Johnson through email. She told me the other account was not closed by Travis. The account was closed by the bank for lack of activity and no funds. I again attempted to contact Travis with the same results. We have no other phone number or address for Travis.
