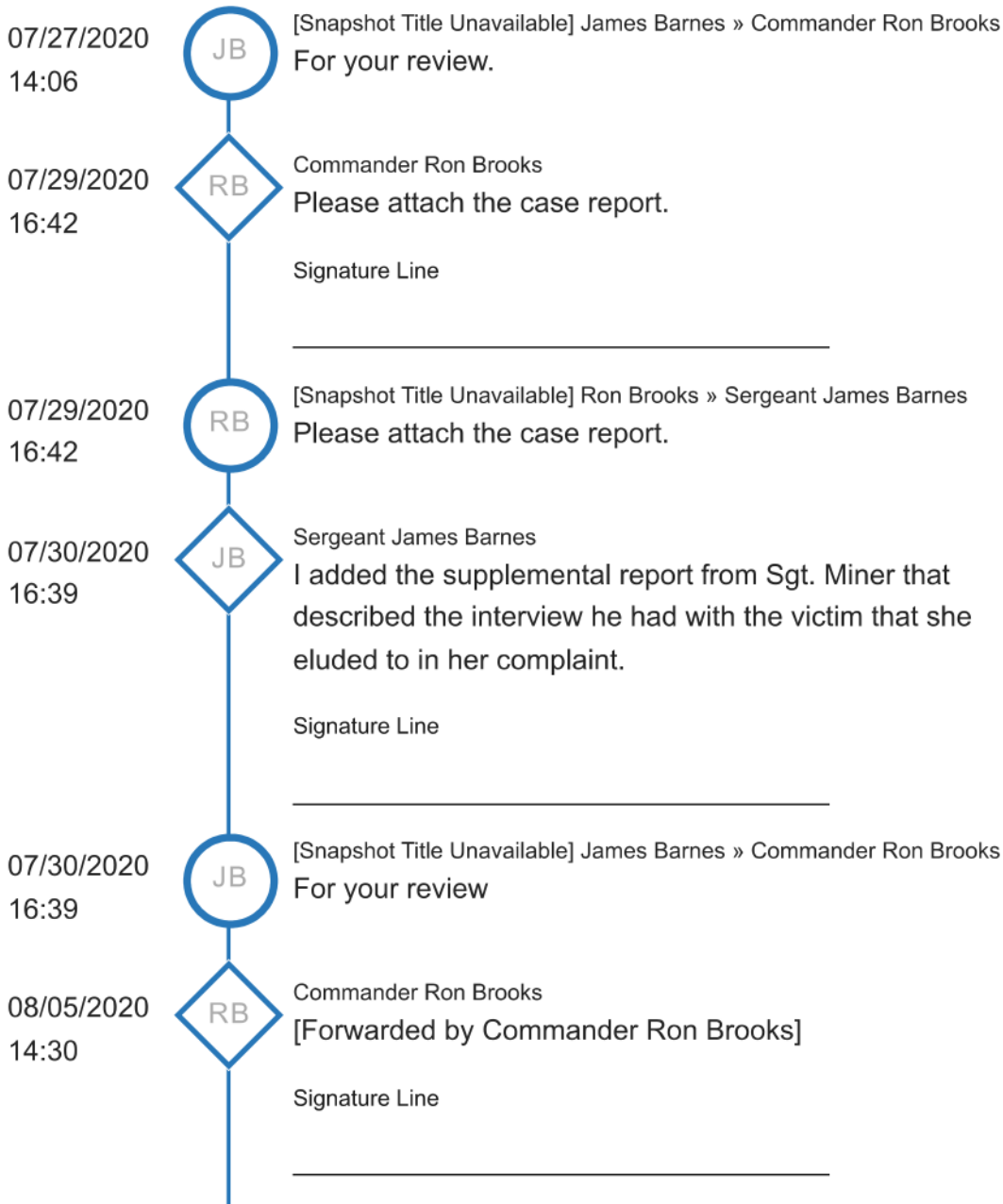

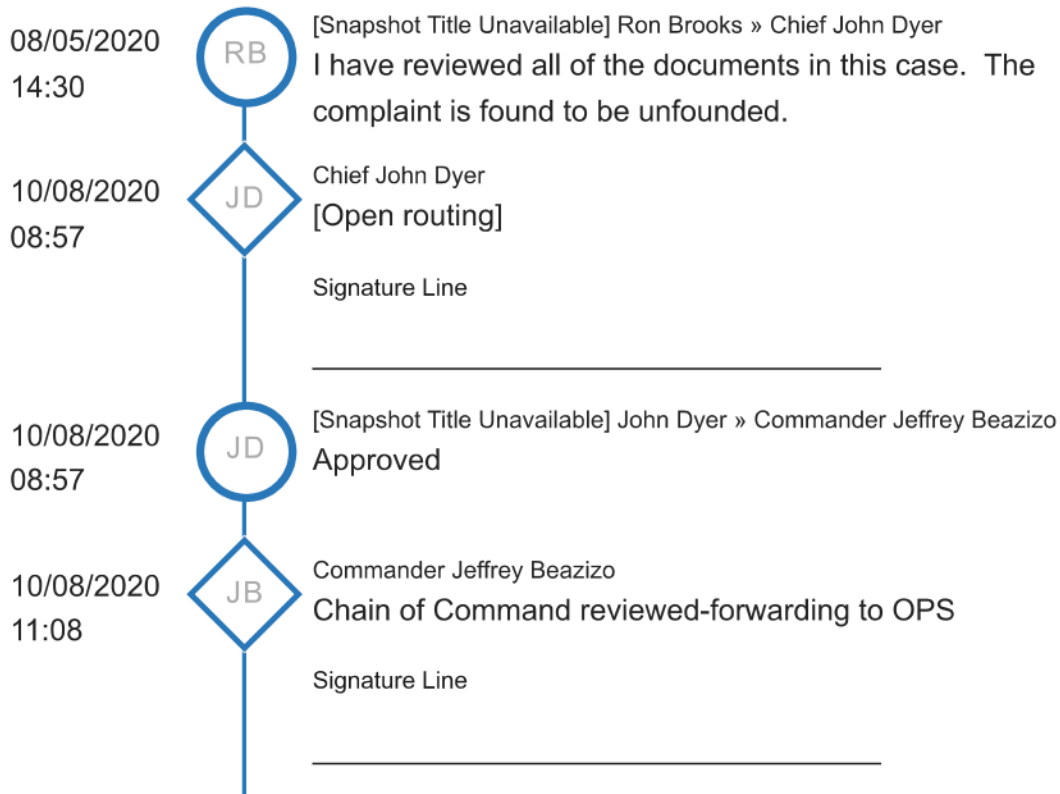

Lake Stevens Police Department When I was 16 I was sexually assaulted by a boy in my math class and I came to you for help. An older man took over my case as a 'detective' . And when I told him my story he proceeded to interrogate me, He told me I wanted it, He told me it "sounds like you just felt guilty for cheating on your boyfriend", He told me I wasnt raped, He brought a woman into the room to "make me feel more comfortable" and continued to dictate what had happened to me, to shame me for what I didnt do right in the situation, belittle my character in front of her. When I was already feeling so alone and outcasted from what had been done to me, your police officer broke me even more. You stripped me of more than what I had already been stripped of with the assault, You abolished my trust with the police, with telling anyone, you made me feel like it wasnt real, like my pain wasnt justified. You gave me no justice. I want you to know that you failed me. That every single day since I was assaulted and every single day since I walked into your building for help I have been suffocating. I cant eat, I cant sleep,

I cant have relationships, I cant have sex, I cant feel comfortable talking to the police. No amount of therapy and medicating has eased me of this gaping hole in my chest. It's been years since I've stepped foot in your doors yet the sound of your police officers voice shaming me still haunts my dreams. I have CPTSD now, I was already fragile from childhood trauma when it had happened but after the assault my brain became debilitated, I will have this for the rest of my life. I will never live a normal life again and thanks to you I will never be at peace or feel like there were any measures taken to protect me, or bring justice to what has been done to me. I was traumatized the day he raped me but I was ruined the day I reported it. Can you tell me something? If your daughter walked into the police station after being raped would you have told her she wanted it?
